WJPA Youth Photography Contest

Rules & Guidelines - please read carefully:

1. Photos must be of domestic poultry only: ducks, geese, turkeys, pigeons, chickens, guineas.

No photos of wild poultry, birds or game will be considered.

2. Entries must be 5 x 7, unframed and unmatted.

3. Entry fee is **\$1 per photo** (cash or check); you may enter as many photos as you wish to pay for, but you can only win once each year.

4. Entries must be postmarked and emailed by **August 15** and each photo has a **complete entry form** attached to the back. An entry form is the bottom portion of this flyer. Copies are accepted.

5. Photos will be judged on **quality, clarity, and composition**. The bird(s) must be the main subject.

6. Entries taken by a person that is similar or nearly identical to that person's winning photo the previous year will not be considered (avoid same/similar bird in the same/similar background).

7. All entries become the property of the Wisconsin Junior Poultry Assoc. and may be reproduced.

Winning photos will become the cover photo for our Facebook page for one month.

8. **ALL CONTESTANTS must provide a JPEG file of their photos at the time of entry to be eligible to win.** **Email entries to:** wjpa.info@gmail.com

9. Prizes will be distributed at the Portage Show in September! Winners do not need to be present to win!

Wisconsin Junior Poultry Association State 2019 Egg Show

This contest is open to all youth 18 years and under who are currently producing eggs from a home flock. Only domestic eggs can be considered.

1. There is no entry fee, and club membership is not required to exhibit.
2. Entries will be accepted on Saturday morning September 28th, in the youth exhibit area at the Columbia County Fairgrounds between 8:00am and 9:00am.
3. Judging will take place at approximately 2:00pm. Trophy awards will be presented at the Youth Awards Ceremony at approximately 4:00pm. All entries must remain in place until 5:00pm.
4. Exhibitors are allowed one entry per class. Trophies sponsored by the Wisconsin Junior Poultry Association will be awarded to the top entry in each class.

Classes

Class 1 – One dozen white eggs in carton

Class 2 – One dozen brown eggs in carton

Class 3 – One dozen naturally occurring eggs of color (green eggs, blue eggs, etc)

Class 4- One plate of three all other eggs such as quail, duck, turkey, pheasant, goose, etc. This class excludes chicken eggs.

Class 5 – Half-dozen decorated eggs.

Be creative! Decorate in any artistic manner or medium. Display may not exceed 15” x 15” x 15”. Entry can be displayed on a board, in a box, basket, or other appropriate container. If you plan to save your display, you may want to blow out the eggs before you begin your display.

*** Note: All entered eggs are intended for exhibition purposes only and should not be used as food after the competition.**

5. Entries will be judged on: · Information · Composition · Originality · Appearance
6. Trophies will be awarded in three age divisions. Ages will be determined as of January 1st , 2019.
 - Junior Division – age 10 and under
 - Intermediate Division – 11-13 years old
 - Senior Division – 14-18 years old.
7. Entries will be accepted between 8:00am and 9:00am at the 2019 Wisconsin International Poultry Club Youth show on Saturday, September 28th at the Columbia County Fairgrounds in Portage, Wisconsin. Posters will be judged in place beginning at 2:00pm. Awards will be presented at the Youth Awards Ceremony on Saturday after approximately 4:00pm.
