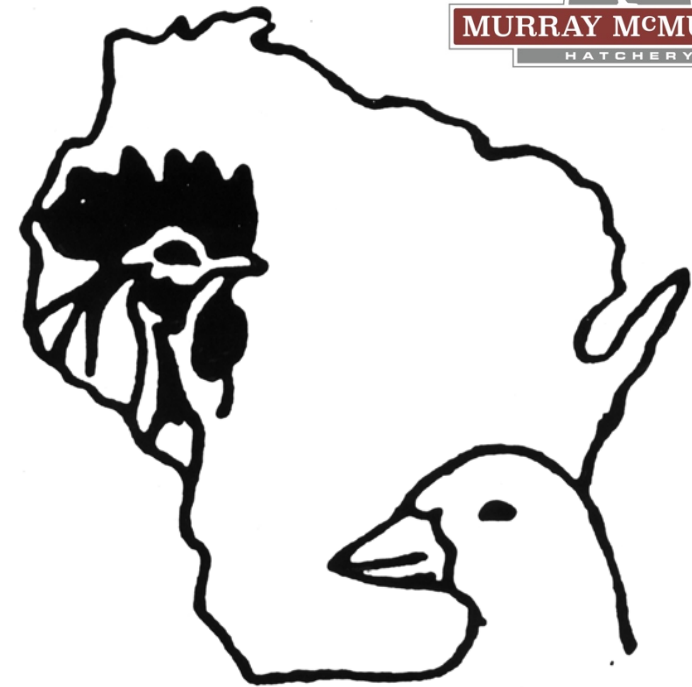

SHOW RULES:

Entry Deadline: Postmarked by Friday, September 4th, 2026

Online Entry deadline Midnight Friday, September 4th, 2026. Available at poultry-hub.com/wips, pay via paypal or check.

ALL WISCONSIN ENTRIES MUST include your state Premise ID number on the entry form.

- **ENTRIES:** Fees are **\$4.00 per bird** entered. Double coops and trios will be respectively double or triple the per bird fees. This includes junior exhibitors showing in the open class. The show committee retains the ability to change cooping layout as situations require. Checks are made payable to WIPC. Exhibitors choosing to enter online will be required to pay via paypal or check, including processing fees. Health paperwork must be uploaded digitally with your online entry. Enter online at poultryhub.com.
- **JUNIOR SHOW:** Fees are **\$4.00 per bird** entered. The show is open to exhibitors 18 years of age by January 1st of this show year or younger. Remember to **mark** your entry blank with "**Junior**" if entering the Junior Show. You may also show different birds in the Open Show. All rules applying to the Open Show apply to the Junior Show, except awards.

- Entries must be marked—Bantam, Large Fowl, Guinea, Duck, Goose, Bearded or Non-Bearded, Single Comb or Rosecomb, Trio, etc. Leg bands are recommended for all birds entered in the show.
- AGE OF COCKERELS AND PULLETS: 1 year old or less as of show date.
- DISPLAYS: A display consists of at least Cock, Hen, Cockerel, Pullet and one Trio (young or old). **There are no displays in the Junior Show.**
- TRIOS: A trio consists of a cock and two hens (old trio), or a cockerel and two pullets (young trio). Remember trios are judged as 3, not individually. **There are no trios in the Junior Show.**
- WATERFOWL: Geese will be cooped in pairs, unless otherwise requested on entry form.
- The APA point system will be used. The more birds shown, the more points are possible.
- APA rules will govern this show, unless otherwise stated. Any case not provided for in those rules would be referred to the WIPC Executive Show Committee. Their decision will be final. Executive Show Committee members are: Kaylyn Schleicher, Terry Lund, Karl Breneman, Nicole Peters, and Butch Gunderson.
- **To protect our exhibits, we will be closing the buildings Sunday at 8:30 a.m. and they will remain closed until the end of our auction, and awards. Upon completion of awards the buildings will be reopened for the release of all exhibits.**
- **WIPC, its Executive Show Committee and officers, will not be responsible for any theft, loss, injury, or sickness of birds brought to this show. However, all reasonable precautions will be taken to protect the exhibits (buildings will be locked at night & during awards ceremony)**
- To exhibit a bird in this show, the bird must be owned 30 days prior to showing and all necessary health paperwork is done.
- The WIPC will accept pigeon entries for the JUNIOR SHOW only.
- SHOW BUILDING: It will be open to accept entries on Friday from 2:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. and Saturday from 7:00 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. **All birds must remain on exhibit until after the awards are presented, which will be no later than 11:00 a.m. on Sunday.**
- **Any exhibitor removing birds from the show and leaving before dismissal, without permission of the show committee will forfeit all trophies, cash awards, placings and points and will not be allowed to enter future WIPC sponsored shows.**
- **JUDGING WILL BEGIN IN JUNIOR & OPEN AT 9:00 a.m. SATURDAY.**
Two judges will be assigned to the Junior Show and three judges will be assigned to the Open Show.
- All classes will be judged through 5th place, with ribbons available through 3rd place for the Junior Show.
- The judges will be instructed by Show officers not to award 1st Place to a bird not worthy of the placement due to lack of competition.
- The WIPC will not be responsible for awards offered by others. All the winner's names will be forwarded to the Club or individual offering the award. Please note: any awards placed after the printing of this catalog will be posted at the show.
- FEED: Kalmbach will be donating various types of poultry feed. All exhibitors will be responsible for the feeding and watering their own birds. ONE plastic water cup will be available per cage.
- BEDDING: Pine shavings will be provided in each cage, donated by Tractor Supply Company of Portage, WI. No additional bedding will be available at the show. Exhibitors may bring extra bedding, but it must be wood shavings.

Check in at the Show Secretary's Table upon arrival.
Report any errors on coop tags to the Show Secretary for correction.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

Wisconsin Dept. of Agriculture requires Pullorum-Typhoid testing on all birds to be exhibited. All poultry must originate from flocks designated as “U.S. Pullorum –Typhoid clean” (all poultry except turkeys) or “Mycoplasma Gallisepticum Clean” (Turkeys) under the N.P.I.P or from equivalent flocks, or have had a Pullorum – Typhoid test within 90 days prior to showing. Due to enforcement of Ag Dept. rules, **entries WILL NOT be accepted** without proper Pullorum-Typhoid clean forms. Please include with your entry a **copy** of either: NPIP certification of your flock, Wisconsin Tested Flock Certification, Wisconsin Associate Flock Certification, or a copy of Pullorum Test Report done within 90 days of the show. In addition, **all Wisconsin exhibitors must have a Wisconsin Livestock ID # on their entry forms**. We recommend that you band all of your birds.

For OUT OF STATE birds: (copied from the WI Dept. of Ag. Website)

Importing poultry, domesticated waterfowl and farm-raised game birds from outside Wisconsin Required:

- Participation in the NPIP or equivalent program and flock classification as “U.S. pullorum-typhoid clean” (all poultry except turkeys) or “U.S. pullorum-typhoid clean” and “Mycoplasma gallisepticum clean” (turkeys)
- Certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI) with physical destination address OR form VS 9-3 (Report of Sales of Hatching Eggs, Chicks and Poults) for animals from flocks enrolled in the NPIP

SWAPPERS SECTION:

There will be no inside swap area or cages provided. **Only show exhibitors** may bring birds to sell. All sales are “private treaty” between seller and buyer. Seller is responsible for filing proper sales records with the Department of Agriculture. Outside seller’s fee is \$15.00 payable at the time of entry or \$20.00 payable on show day. Outdoor sales only.

SHOW SET UP DATE:

Showroom set-up will be Sunday, September 20th, 2026 starting at 9 a.m. and should be completed by 3:30 p.m. Lunch is provided. Everyone’s help is greatly appreciated.

SHOW TAKE DOWN:

Immediately after birds are released on Sunday, we begin to take down cages and clean buildings. All are encouraged to join us. **Even if you can help for just an hour or so it would help immensely**. Our show does not have a clean-up fee as other shows do. With all of our cages stored in racks and loaded with a fork lift, clean-up goes quickly. Lunch will be provided for those who help.

ALCOHOL:

Columbia County Fairgrounds strictly prohibits any alcoholic beverage on the Fairgrounds.

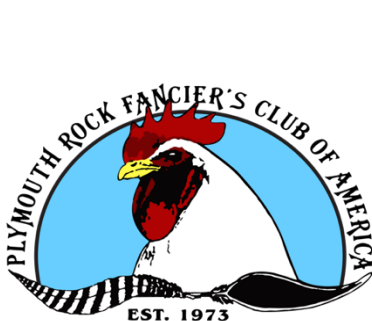

This contest is open to all youth 18 years and under who are currently producing eggs from a home flock. Only domestic eggs can be considered.

1. There is a \$1 entry fee. WJPA membership is not required to exhibit.
 2. Entries will be accepted on Saturday morning September 26th, in the youth exhibit area at the Columbia County Fairgrounds between 8:00am and 9:00am.
 3. Judging will take place at approximately 2:00pm. Awards will be presented at the Youth Awards Ceremony at approximately 4:00pm. All entries must remain in place until 5:00pm.
 4. Exhibitors are allowed one entry per class. Awards will be awarded to the top entry in each class.
- Classes
- Class 1** – One dozen white eggs in carton
- Class 2** – One dozen brown eggs in carton
- Class 3** – One dozen naturally occurring eggs of color (green eggs, blue eggs, etc)
- Class 4** – One plate of three all other eggs such as quail, duck, turkey, pheasant, goose (excludes chicken eggs).
- Class 5** – Half-dozen decorated eggs.

Be creative! Decorate in any artistic manner or medium. Display may not exceed 15" x 15" x 15". Entry can be displayed on a board, in a box, basket, or other appropriate container. If you plan to save your display, you may want to blow out the eggs before you begin your display.

* Note: All entered eggs are intended for exhibition purposes only and should not be used as food after the competition.
